## MT. LEBANON, PENNSYLVANIA RESOLUTION NO. R-10-14

## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 1340 AND HOUSE BILL 1272 ENABLING MUNICIPAL POLICE TO USE THE SAME MOTOR VEHICLE SPEED-TIMING EQUIPMENT AS THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE

**Whereas**, public protection is a principal reason why municipalities are established and exist; and

**Whereas**, municipal police and the Pennsylvania State Police are statutorily authorized to protect the public, primarily through the enforcement of the Crimes Code and Motor Vehicle Code; and

*Whereas*, all of the tools of law enforcement that are statutorily available to the Pennsylvania State Police are also statutorily available to municipal police, with one notable exception, that being radar.

**Whereas**, Pennsylvania is the only state in the United States of America that prohibits local police from using a common and effective piece of speed-timing equipment that the Pennsylvania State Police are permitted to use; and

*Whereas*, Pennsylvania has the distinction as the state with the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest number of speed-related vehicle fatalities and the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest percentage of speed-related vehicle fatalities in the country.
